

RE: GBR IRC Committee – Rating Office Report 2018

DATE: 13<sup>th</sup> September 2018

#### **INTRODUCTION**

IRC continues to have good numbers in the UK with the greatest number of certificates in any of the IRC countries. We continue to see good support for the strong racing areas in the UK, but the drop in the Central South Coast is concerning. The UK based IRC Classes such as the HP30, Performance 40 and Fast 40+ have a good programme of races. Attendance at events has been good with particular good entries in the offshore racing. The IRC Europeans in Cowes had lower entries than expected and the number of GBR boats attending the Combined ORC/IRC Worlds was disappointing.

### **GBR IRC Statistics**

To avoid confusion all numbers listed are to the end of August each year. In general we see this value increase by approximately 40 boats between that date and the end of the year.

In 2018 we have seen a slight decrease of 46 boats (3%) in the number of boats holding full IRC certificates at the end of August. Details are shown in the table below.

The total number of shorthanded certificates issued this year was 16, 13 of these are in the Central South Coast region where there is strong support for single- and double-handed racing. Also a total of 37 boats had SERs issued (a reduction from 53 in 2017). This brings the total number of boats racing IRC up to 1402 for the year to the end of August.

The following table shows the total number of boats with full IRC certificates, including those issued under the Start Up Scheme, to 31 Dec 2015, 2016 & 2017. 2018 figures are to the end of August and also show number of Short-Handed certificates in each area, and Single Event Ratings. **See below for more about Start Up and SER.**

Start Up and the Club Loyalty Scheme (CLS) continues to deliver good results year on year. In 2018 Start Up and CLS equated to 13% of the total GBR boats rated and this year again Start Up has exceeded last year's total. This is primarily down to the excellent relationships we have with the Clubs and the passion they share for IRC. We never underestimate the efforts the individuals in the clubs put in and appreciate their drive and commitment.

The total number of boats issued certificates under this scheme has risen from 154 in 2017 to 187 in 2018 so far. The distribution is shown below:

## Winter Weighing and Measuring Discount Scheme

The winter weighing and discount scheme was continued in October to December in 2017. The scheme is for boat owners to get their boat measured wishing to obtain an IRC Certificate in the following year. There is a 35% discount for a boat measurement in this winter period and the data is then saved and applied to the rating in the following year. This scheme is also good as it spreads the workload for the measurer throughout the year. The uptake for 2017 saw a good number weighed and measured, and we are reviewing whether we continue the scheme in 2018.

### IRC Application Process and MyIRC

This year has seen successful continued use of the MyIRC online application portal. A new service to owners not now includes upload of their IRC certificates (including trials) to their MyIRC account so they can login and acquire them at any time.

The MyIRC system continues to look at options for use by Rule Authorities in other countries.

# **Rating Office Staff**
