



## ***IRC European Championship SANREMO 2019***



The 4<sup>th</sup> edition of the *IRC European Championship* will take place in SANREMO in 2019 and will be organized by the Yacht Club SANREMO, historic club in Italy.

Born in 1920, this club matters among his members famous names, world champions and Olympic champions, as well as members of the Italian team of America's Cup.

With Cork in 2016, Marseilles in 2017 and Cowes in 2018, the *IRC European Championship* alternates between the North and the South of Europe, the Atlantic Ocean, the Mediterranean Sea, Channel, the proof of the ambition of this Championship and its success with the IRC competitors.

The Gulf of Genoa will welcome the best IRC boats of Europe and besides the world during a competition raised the last week of June 2019, just after the arrival of the Rolex Giraglia Cup to Genes.



The Yacht Club of SANREMO will offer a luxurious and friendly frame for this edition 2019. All the Italian hospitality will be implemented to offer to the sailors and to the officials the best of the welcome during all the competition.

The race will be opened to IRC boats in a very wide range of rating. It will allow the smallest boats as the biggest to compete for the title of *IRC 2019 European Champion*. The fleet will be divided into classes, but, at the end of the week, a single Champion of Europe will be crowned.

Each edition groups the best crews worldwide. The Netherlands, Denmark and the United States are already represented among the subscribers for the 2018 edition in Cowes.

The 2019 edition in SANREMO will not make an exception. The Mediterranean Basin abounds in competitive fleets of all origins: Belgium, France, Greece, Spain, Malta, Russia, Turkey, United Kingdom and United States... to quote that they will be firmly expected by the Italians racers !
