IRC Constitution Changes for 2023







1. GOVERNANCE - IRC POLICY STEERING GROUP

Reason for change: The IRC Board has replaced the IRC Policy Steering Group (PSG) and this change reflects that position in the IRC Constitution. In accordance with IRC Constitution clause 4.7, RORC and UNCL approve the change.

Amend IRC Constitution Clause 4.1:

4.1 Policy direction of IRC is controlled by the IRC Board Policy Steering Group taking into account recommendations from the IRC Congress. The IRC Board comprises two representatives of RORC, two representatives of UNCL, and a fifth member appointed by RORC and UNCL together. Policy Steering Group comprises representatives of RORC and UNCL, and one representative of IIOA elected by the IRC Congress. The IIOA representative shall be elected annually

Effect: To replace IRC PSG with IRC Board in the IRC Constitution.
